Dear Parent,

As part of our History project about The Romans, Year 4 will be visiting Caerleon Roman Legionary Fortress and Museum on **Tuesday 10th March**. We will be visiting the remains of a Roman amphitheatre, barracks and baths. We will also have the opportunity to see a replica barracks and to try on replica armour.

We will be travelling by coach to Caerleon. We will need to leave promptly at 9.00am and will return for the end of the normal school day. The children will wear **school uniform** and will need to bring a **warm waterproof-coat and a pair of wellies/change of shoes in a named carrier bag**. They will also need a **packed lunch** and a **screw-top drink**.

In order for the trip to take place, we need to ask you for £7.50 to cover our travel costs and museum staff-led workshops during our visit. Unless we receive enough contributions to cover the cost, the trip cannot take place. Please make your payment by **Wednesday 4th March** to ensure that the trip is viable. **If you have any concerns regarding payment of this trip, please contact Mrs Cowan.**

Payment and consent for this trip should be made online through the ParentPay facility. Alternatively, you can pay in cash through local stores where you see the Paypoint logo. Those parents wishing to pay cash using the Paypoint facility should contact the school office to request a barcode.

Please inform the school office or indicate in the notes field in ParentPay, if your child is eligible for free school meals and you would like the kitchen to provide a packed lunch on the day of the trip. If you would like to volunteer to help with this trip please speak to your child's teacher.

We really hope that this day will be a wonderful opportunity for the children to have hands-on experiences with Roman artefacts and history as part of our topic, 'What impact did the Romans have on Britain?'
