Dear Parents / Carers,

### Year 3 visit to Windmill Hill City Farm

We have arranged a visit to the wonderful Windmill Hill City Farm in Bristol, to take part in a 'Pick it, Cook it, Eat it' workshop. This will enhance the 'Healthy Eating' part of our Science unit this term and also our Food Technology work.

Each class will be going separately as follows:

Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October – 3W

Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> October – 3AB

Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October – 3L

We will be travelling by coach to Windmill Hill Farm. We will be leaving school at 9.15 and we will be returning to school around 12.45.

**All children will need to bring a packed lunch** which will be eaten back at school. This includes children who normally have a school dinner (just incase we arrive back slightly late during lunch time). **The children should wear school uniform for this trip and have a waterproof coat.** They will also need to take their **water-bottle and fruit snack** in a bag. The activities at the farm will all be outside.

The cost of the trip (to cover coach expenses/entry fees) is **£15.65**. This can now be paid for, and your consent given, via ParentPay. Without your consent, your child will be unable to participate in the trip. Please be aware that whilst this is a voluntary contribution, if there is insufficient funding, we will be unable to meet the costs and the trip will be cancelled. **Please make your payment and parental consent by Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> September at the latest.** A barcode can be issued from the school office if you would prefer to pay via a PayPoint.

### Free School Meals

If your child is eligible for free school meals, please inform the school office or indicate in the notes field in ParentPay if you would like the kitchen to provide a packed lunch on the day of the trip.



Help needed

Each class will need a few parents to accompany them. If you are able to help, please will you see your class teacher, as soon as possible. All parent volunteers need to provide ID and complete some forms from the office in advance of helping in school (this is the case, even if you have previously volunteered in school).
